

## **What does the new CAO 100.5 mean?**

CAO 100.5 carries over from the AD/RAD/43 A6 and AD/INST/8 A4, AD/INST/9 A6 Airworthiness Directives.

It is written in Regulations that the Aircraft Altitude reporting systems are periodically checked for accuracy. Now the CAO 100.5 is broken up into two distinct schedules for inspection.

1. Altimeters and Mode C encoders need to be checked every 2 years.
2. Airspeed and Fuel Quantity system need to be checked every 4 years.
